## *Definition*



Breaking out of policy silos,  
strengthened national agencies  
interoperability, institutionalized  
convergence mechanisms



## GAINS

Horizontal integration of Global commitments is embodied in the Philippine Development Plan (AMBISYON 2040)

National Policy to ensure vertical linkages of local and national priorities is in place (e.g. Alignment of National, Sub-national and Local Plans)

Planning regime are CDRA influenced

## CHALLENGES

Need for a deeper and wider LGU influence in CCA and DRR

Implementation of the plans is characterized by silos due to structures and mandates of implementing institutions

Weak interoperability among national agencies at the sub-national level creates bottleneck in implementation

Accountability mechanism is limited to bottom-up approach influences the reporting system

Financing is highly managed by NGAs and access of LGUs to financing is difficult because of stringent standards and requirements
